Some follow-up discussion took place regarding working with Team Staff to have recommendations submitted by November 20th and (full) Transition Team meetings going forward will be scheduled bi-weekly. Also, Chairperson Kinsella indicated that he will likely be absent from the next meeting (on 10/12).
