JACKSON STREET TRANSPORTATION MASTER PLAN

SUMMARY:

In July of 2021, Escambia County and the City of Pensacola Community Redevelopment Agency entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to develop a transportation master plan called "Reimagine Jackson Street: A Transportation Master Plan" for improvements to West Jackson Street from A Street to Fairfield Drive. In accordance with the MOU, Escambia County and the CRA jointly selected WSP USA, Inc. to develop the master plan in accordance with the County's Request for Qualifications solicitation PD 20-21.051.

The consultant, WSP USA, Inc., will present conceptual options for the project based on preliminary public input and data analysis for discussion.
