2. 24-217 AWARD OF BID #24-011 PENSACOLA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AUTOMATED EXIT LANE BREACH CONTROL

Recommendation: That City Council award Bid #24-011, Automated Exit Lane Breach Control (ELBC) at Pensacola International Airport to Loftis Marine, LLC of Pensacola, Florida, the lowest and most responsible bidder with a base bid of \$299,720.00 plus a 10% contingency of \$29,972.00 for a total of \$329,692.00. Further, that City Council authorize the Mayor to take the actions necessary to execute and administer this contract and complete the work, consistent with the bid, contracting documents, and the Mayor's Executive Powers as granted in the City Charter.

Council Member Patton announced an upcoming *Smoke Alarm Saturday* event in the Eastside Neighborhood.

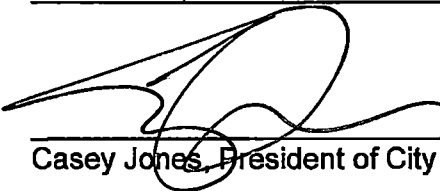

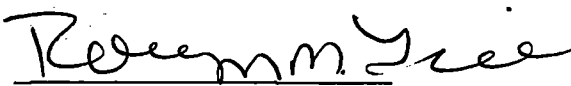
