REVIEW OF CONSENT AGENDA ITEMS

1. 24-393 APPOINTMENT - OPIOID ABATEMENT FUNDING ADVISORY BOARD

Recommendation: That City Council reappoint Tommy White to the Opioid Abatement Funding Advisory Board for a term of two (2) years, expiring May 1, 2026.

2. 24-371 AIRPORT - ACQUISITION OF REAL PROPERTY - 2400 BLOCK LANGLEY AVENUE

Recommendation: That City Council approve the proposed purchase of real property located at 2400 Block Langley Avenue (Parcel No. 141S292100080001 and 141S292100090001) from Diane Bonner Canady in the amount of \$188,850.00 plus closing costs for an estimated total amount of \$200,000.00.

Further, that City Council authorize the Mayor to take the actions necessary to execute and administer the acquisition, consistent with the parameters set herein and consistent with the Mayor's Executive Powers as granted in the City Charter.

3. 24-61 AWARD OF BID NO. 24-021 - ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS TO ZARAGOZA STREET EAST OF TARRAGONA STREET

Recommendation: That City Council award a contract for Bid No. 24-021 for Roadway Improvements to Zaragoza Street east of Tarragona Street, to Chavers Construction, Inc. of Pensacola, FL, the lowest and most responsible bidder with a base bid of \$145,576.00, plus a 5% contingency of \$7,278.80 for a total of \$152,854.80. Further, that City Council authorize the Mayor to take the actions necessary to execute and administer this contract and complete the work, consistent with the bid, contracting documents, and the Mayor's Executive Powers as granted in the City Charter.

4. 24-382 DISCRETIONARY FUNDING ALLOCATION - CITY COUNCIL MEMBER ALLISON PATTON - DISTRICT 6

Recommendation: That City Council approve funding of \$1,000 to the Ministry Village at Olive, \$1,000 to the Rally! Foundation for Childhood Cancer Research and \$1,000 to Family Promise of Escambia County from the City Council Discretionary Funds for District 6.

7. 24-365 ACCEPTANCE OF AWARD OF FLORIDA COMMERCE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT - DISASTER RECOVERY REBUILD FLORIDA HOUSING REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT PROGRAM AGREEMENT NO. HS010

Recommendation: That City Council accept the Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery Grant No. HS010 from the Florida Department of Commerce for the Rebuild Florida Housing Repair and Replacement Program in the amount of \$5,861,500 with a \$250,000 local match for a total grant value of \$6,111,500. Further, that City Council authorize the Mayor to take the actions necessary to execute and administer the grant, consistent with the terms of the grant and the Mayor's Executive Powers as granted in the City Charter. Finally, that City Council adopt a supplemental budget resolution appropriating the funds.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE III OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF PENSACOLA, FLORIDA, AMENDING PURCHASING, CHAPTER 3-3. IN GENERAL, ARTICLE I, SECTION 3-3-1, CONTRACTS FOR PUBLIC WORK AND PURCHASES OF OTHER COMMODITIES AND SERVICES; LOWEST AND BEST RESPONSIBLE BIDDER; REJECTION OF BIDS; APPROVAL OF COUNCIL AND MAYOR; EMERGENCY PURCHASES; SECTION 3-3-3, SMALL BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PROGRAM; SECTION 3-3-5, PROHIBITED CONDUCT BY BIDDERS; CREATING SECTION 3-3-13, USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS IN PROCUREMENTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, REPEALING CLAUSE,

AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
